Abstracts can be submitted for:

- Individual Paper Presentation: 20 minutes including 10 minutes of Q&A
- **Self-Organized Symposium**: 90 minutes around a common theme with a moderator (symposia will be accepted if the presenters are at least three people)
- Poster Presentation: 20 minutes with the speaker available to discuss with participants
- Workshop: 90 minutes

Do not use capital letters for the title of the Abstract except the first one of the first word and when necessary: acronyms, proper nouns...

Please name the abstract file with the name of the presenting author and **upload** the file through the dedicated submission system (as shown below).



The abstract is not successfully submitted until the author receives a confirmation e-mail after clicking the submit button. If the author does not receive a confirmation e-mail, he is kindly requested to contact the Organizing Secretariat MCC (events@mccstudio.org).

Please also note that an author submitting an abstract is not automatically registered for the Conference: regular <u>registration</u> is compulsory and involves payment of the registration fee.

All authors wishing to present their work (including co-authors who will serve as speakers) must be **registered for the conference before the Early Bird deadline** to be included in the official program.

The presenting author will be notified of his/her abstract acceptance by e-mail.
